



Amelia Frawley Mingos

March 9, 1919 - June 26, 2014

Amelia Frawley Mingos, 95, widow of Joseph H. Mingos, passed away Thursday evening, June 26, 2014 at the Skilled Nursing Unit of Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Amelia was born March 9, 1919 in Mendon, NY, the daughter of James L. Frawley and Amelia Ambs Frawley. She grew up on the family farm in Ghent, PA and graduated from St. Agnes High School in Towanda, PA in 1936. After graduation she attended the Lowe School of Business in Binghamton, NY. On January 29, 1942 she married Joseph H. Mingos at SS. Peter and Paul Church in Towanda, PA. The Rev. James Shaughnessy officiated. Father Shaughnessy also officiated at the marriage of her son Joseph E. and his wife Martha twenty-six years later at SS. Peter and Paul's Church. During WWII, while Amelia's husband Joseph was serving in the Army in the South Pacific, she worked at the Myrna Lee Hosiery mill in Towanda. After the war, Amelia became a full time housewife and resided with her family in Towanda. She was a member of SS. Peter and Paul Parish, and a member of the Parish Altar and Rosary Society. After the death of her husband, she resided for about ten years in Athens, PA. Amelia enjoyed gardening, baking, reading, crossword puzzles, neighborhood functions, spending time with her grandchildren and traveling to Miami, FL to visit her daughter.

She is survived by: daughter Marilyn and husband Chico Fernandez of Miami, FL, sons, Joseph and wife Martha of Sayre, PA, William and wife Susan of
