Andrew J. Viselli, 85, of Sayre, passed away at his home on Thursday, June 13, 2013. Andrew was born on July 13, 1927 in Sayre, the son of Auriellio and Erma Quattrini Viselli. Andrew served in the United States Navy as a Seabee in the US Navy Construction Battalion. He married Phyllis Conley on December 26, 1960.

Andrew owned and operated the local barber shop on Lockhart Street in Sayre with his business partner and friend, Bud Waite, for fifty-four years. He was an active member of the Epiphany Parish in Sayre, The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Lodge No. 1148, the Roma Madre Lodge No. 1342 Order Sons of Italy, the Skiff-Bower VFW No. 1536, and J.E. Wheelock Hose No. 5. Andrew enjoyed puttering around with his brother Joe and spending time with his family, particularly his granddaughter, Phoebe.

Andrew is survived by his wife, Phyllis; daughter, Anne Viselli and her husband Peter Weller; granddaughter, Phoebe Weller; and many beloved nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

In addition to his parents, Andrew is preceded in death by his sister, Clara Graham and brothers, Anthony and Joseph Viselli.

A Memorial Mass for Andrew will be held at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 18,

2013 at the Epiphany Parish, Sayre, with Rev. Vincent Langan as celebrant. There are no calling hours. Interment will be in Epiphany Cemetery, Sayre, Pa. following the service.
