Anetta S. (Chilson) Soper, 76, of Wysox, PA passed away on Tuesday, June 21, 2022.

Born in Wysox at her parents' home on October 29, 1946, she was the daughter of the late Joseph and Joyce (Rozzell) Chilson the second oldest of ten children.
