Ann Michelle Bayait Dickerson, 64, of Monroeton, PA passed away Sunday morning, December 31, 2023, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Ann was born September 18, 1959, in Somerville, NJ a daughter of Patrick Joseph Bayait and Agnes “Aggie” Emma Ambs Bayait.
