



## Anne M Thompson Haglich

February 6, 1921 - October 2, 2017

Anne M. Thompson-Haglich, 96, of Towanda, Pennsylvania, passed away on Monday, Oct. 2, 2017.

Born on Feb. 6, 1921, in Albany, New York, she was the daughter of the late Wasyl and Rose Moskalyk. She grew up in Troy, New York, where she attended Ukrainian school and was active in the Ukrainian community. After graduating from Troy High School and Albany Business School, she was employed by General Electric in Schenectady, New York, where she designed schematics for elevator controls in support of the war effort during World War II.

On June 2, 1946, she married Thomas C. Thompson Sr. at St. Nicholas Ukrainian Orthodox Church in Troy, New York. After their marriage, they moved several times, eventually settling in Towanda in 1959, where Tom managed the J.J. Newberry's store on Main Street for many years. Anne was a stay-at-home mother until her youngest son started high school and she began working for the Towanda School District. Anne eventually became the secretary to the Towanda School Board, a position she held for many years until her retirement. Tom and Anne were married for 45 years until his death in 1992. Together, Tom and Anne raised three sons.

In November 1998, Anne married Peter Haglich at Ss. Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church in Towanda. She and Peter enjoyed a loving relationship for 19 years until her death. Peter devoted himself to caring for Anne throughout her courageous battle with Alzheimer's disease.

In addition to her parents and first husband, Thomas Sr., Anne was also predeceased by her brother, Thomas Moskalyk; her sister, Peg Kendrick; and an infant grandson. Anne is survived by her husband, Peter; her children, Thomas Jr. (Elizabeth) of Towanda, William (Lillian) of Springfield, Pennsylvania, Robert (Lisa) of Allentown, Pennsylvania; six grandchildren, Lennon, T., Bridget, Peter, Rebecca and Anthony; seven great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. Anne is also survived by Peter's children, Peter (Kathy) Haglich Jr. of Virginia Beach, Virginia, and Helen (Ray) Stolinas of Bellefonte, Pennsylvania, and Peter's grandchildren. In addition, Anne is survived by her former daughter-in-law, Lennon Bancroft Thompson of Wysox, Pennsylvania, with whom she enjoyed an especially close and loving relationship.

Anne will always be remembered as a loving wife, mother, grandmother and friend who enjoyed cooking, gardening and sitting around the table visiting with family and friends. For Anne, family always came first and she was known to forego her needs for the happiness of her family.
