Anthony Cheresnowsky, 84, of 512 Mowhawk St. Sayre, PA passed away Saturday morning, February 14, 2015 at his home following declining health. Anthony was born in Sayre on June 6, 1930 the son of Wesley and Sonia Katchmar Cheresnowsky. He was a graduate of Sayre High School class of 1948.

Anthony served in the US Marine Corps for one year and with the Army Air Corps for four years. He was a graduate of Lock Haven University where he received his Bachelor of Science degree and later received his Masters degree in Science from Syracuse University. Mr. Cheresnowsky was the recipient of the National Science Foundation Scholarship and received extra credit from Yale and Cornell Universities. He served as a math and physics instructor for the Owego-Apalachin School District for over 30 years until his retirement.
