



## Arthur H. Young

May 9, 1918 - September 6, 2012

On Thursday, September 6, 2012, Arthur H. Young, 94, a long time resident of Ulster, PA passed away at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA.

Arthur was born May 9, 1918 in Westover, PA the son of Edward P. and Mildred Ginn Young. He was a graduate of Cherry Tree High School Class of 1935. In 1937, Arthur became employed as a milk tester for the Dairy Herd Improvement Association (DHIA). He was subsequently employed by GLF in Milan for 9 years and by GLF in Athens for a year.

On June 25, 1940 he married the former Elizabeth F. McKeon in the Ulster United Methodist Parsonage.

Arthur later accepted employment with Sylvania Electric in Towanda where he was associated for 32 years until his retirement on September 30, 1984.

He was a dedicated and active member of the Ulster United Methodist Church where he taught Sunday school, was a choir member and served as financial secretary for many years. Arthur was a member and treasurer of the Ulster-Sheshequin Fire Company for a number of years and served as treasurer for the Ulster Municipal Authority for many years since it's inception in 1966. He was an active member of the Boy Scouts Committee in Ulster and served as an Ulster School Board Director for many years. Arthur was a member of Wysox IOOF Lodge No. 1152.
