



Brian Jon Haverly

March 4, 1975 - January 30, 2024

Brian Jon Haverly, 48, originally of Towanda, Pennsylvania, and most recently of Pahoia, Hawaii, passed away on January 30, 2024.

Brian was born March 4, 1975, to Greg & Diana Haverly in Sayre, Pennsylvania. During his years in Towanda, Brian enjoyed sports including Little League, football, and wrestling. After graduating from Towanda High School in 1994, Brian spent a semester at Wilkes University before enlisting in the United States Army. Brian completed basic and advanced training at Fort Knox, Kentucky. He served as a 19D, tanker and after three years of active service was honorably discharged in 1998. After active duty, Brian served several years in the Pennsylvania National Guard and Army Reserve, eventually reclassifying as a Psychological Operations Specialist. He earned several awards and decorations, including the Army Achievement Medal, the National Guard Recruiting Ribbon, and German marksmanship and physical fitness medals. Brian was incredibly proud to serve his country and was a fine noncommissioned officer. After his military service, he became a corrections officer at the Bradford County Prison before becoming a Federal Corrections Officer in Sheridan, Oregon. Brian was a member of the Special Operations Response Team at FCI Sheridan and attained the rank of Lieutenant with the Bureau of Prisons. Most recently, he was employed at the Federal Detention Center in Honolulu, Hawaii. Brian enjoyed spending time outdoors fishing, hunting, and hiking. He also loved trying to make new dishes in the kitchen

(with mixed success but always joyful in the process), and the attention of a pretty girl. Brian was a loving and caring person that left a memorable impression on most who met him.

Brian was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents James Jr. & Louise Miller, paternal grandparents Harold & MaryAnn Haverly, Uncles Glenn Haverly, Gary Haverly, and James Miller, III, and Aunt Gyla Haverly Bailey. He is survived by his parents Greg & Diana Haverly, brother Dr. Dusty Haverly, brother-in-law Dr. Brett Groff, his first wife Sonya Kingsley, and several cousins.

Visiting hours will be held Sunday, February 25th, 2024, at Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home, 217 York Avenue, Towanda, Pennsylvania at 12 noon with service beginning at 1:30 PM. Pastor Catherine Dawes from the Monroeton United Methodist Church, where Brian was a member, will be officiating.
