



Brian Eugene Mastrantonio

June 9, 1959 - August 6, 2013

Brian Eugene Mastrantonio, 54, of 34 William St., Sayre, passed away on August 6, 2013 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre. Brian was born in Sayre on June 9, 1959, the son of Alexander Mastrantonio Sr. and Sandra Mastrantonio Weber. Brian grew up and attended school in Sayre. After graduating high school, he attended Williamsport Area College, where he received his associate degree in business. On August 9, 2013, Brian married Maria Conner, and together would have celebrated their 33rd anniversary this year.

Brian was a wonderful, sweet, kind, and loving man. He was a precious and loving husband and father. He loved life, people, and animals. Brian suffered greatly for many years with Von Hippel-Lindau Disease (VHL). He had over 30 surgeries because of it but Brian loved life so much he took it as his cross to bear. For his wife, Maria, taking care of Brian was a privilege and a grace. He would go into surgery with a smile on his face, telling his wife, Maria, and his daughter, Aleena, "It'll be okay. We'll be back together at 34 William Street soon."

Brian was a big fan of the New York Jets and he loved rock n' roll music. He passed his love of music onto Aleena, his daughter. He loved cars, especially Bonneville's. His friends affectionately called him "Bonneville Brian". He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus.

Brian always saw the bright side of everything and the good in all people. As he said, life is a blessing; he lived everyday knowing it was a gift from God.

Brian is survived by his loving and caring wife, Maria Mastrantonio; daughter, Aleena Mastrantonio; mother, Sandra Weber and husband, Louis, of Forksville; brothers, Alexander Mastrantonio Jr. of Sayre and Shawn Mastrantonio and wife, Kimberly, of Sayre; step-sister, Melissa Weber and husband, Andrew, of Pine City; mother-in-law, Maria Walsh of Arizona; brother-in-law, Charles Conner and wife, Sherri; uncle, Fredrick Barnes and wife, Joyce; and several nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, and uncles.

Brian is preceded in death by his father, Alexander Mastrantonio Sr. in 1980; father-in-law, William Joseph Conner in 1994; and his paternal and maternal grandparents.

A mass of Christian burial will be held for Brian at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 10, 2013 at the Church of the Epiphany, Sayre. Interment will be in the Tioga Point Cemetery, Athens. 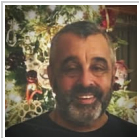
