



## Budd William Clark

September 28, 1951 - April 22, 2023

Budd William Clark of Wysox passed away at Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, surrounded by his family on April 22, 2023. Budd (Buddy) was a lifelong resident of Wysox and the proprietor of Clark Furniture Inc. and Clark's Carpetland. He worked in all aspects of the business along with his father Budd M. Clark. Buddy, along with his father Budd were instrumental in the naming of The Golden Mile section of Route 6 in Wysox PA. Buddy was born on September 28th 1951, in Towanda. He attended Wysox Elementary where he participated in Boy Scouts and Little League and was an active youth at the Towanda United Methodist Church. He also loved his many pets over the course of his life.
