On May 7, 2024, Catherine M. "Kate" Bride passed away at the age of 90. She was born in Scranton, PA on February 2, 1934 to parents John and Agnes (Winnicka) Warezak. She was predeceased by her parents and siblings as well as her husband of 62 years, John (Bill) Bride, and eldest child, Timothy Bride. There she graduated from Sayre High School and met her future husband at the local roller-skating rink. Kate and Bill married August 2, 1958 at the Church of the Epiphany. After which she moved to Liberty Corners where she learned just how dark and quiet it gets in the country and how to help her husband run the family farm. They built their forever house on the farm and Kate became the matriarch of a large and ever-expanding family where she lovingly welcomed each new member, devoting herself to each of them. She loved to read, garden, and was an excellent cook, her tubs of cookies legendary. Her home was always an open door for a meal, a sweet treat, or a

sewing emergency for generation after generation. Kate was a devout Catholic and member of Saints Peter and Paul Church.
