Chad Richard Sindoni, 26, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday January 26,

2016. Chad is the beloved son of Jon and Amanda Sindoni and the brother of Alexandria and Abigail Sindoni. Born April 2, 1989 in Sayre, PA, Chad was a 2007 graduate of Athens Area High School.

Chad was well-known in the valley wrestling community as both a long-time Athens High School wrestler and a current Assistant Coach for the Sayre High School varsity wrestling team. At Athens, Chad was a three-time medalist at the PIAA Class AA Wrestling Championships, including a second-place finish his senior year. Chad finished his high school career with 128 wins and remains 5th on the Athens High School all-time win list. Chad fell in love with wrestling at the age of 5 and remained an avid fan of the sport throughout his life. He found tremendous reward in helping other wrestlers through his coaching, guidance, and constant encouragement. He felt great pride in the wrestlers he worked with. Coaching wrestling was truly his greatest passion. Chad was also a fierce and devoted fan of the Dallas Cowboys, the Notre Dame Fighting Irish, and Boston Red Sox, all of which were great passions he shared with his mother, father, and sisters. He loved the road trips to Notre Dame for football games and was able to enjoy one of these trips with them this past fall. Chad also found tremendous enjoyment in stock car building & racing and spent many hours with his grandfather Enie and cousins Doug & Dougie working on the next great car. He will be dearly missed by both his

wrestling and racing families.

Chad was predeceased by his loving grandmother Patty Brown, his grandfather Richard Brown, his step-uncle Richie Brown, and his great-grandparents Helen and Tony Daddona.

He is survived by his beloved parents, Jon and Amanda Sindoni; adoring sisters Alex and Abby; loving girlfriend Raven Worthing; future brother-in-law Jeremy Baird; grandparents Patty & Enie Vanderpool and Frank & Bonnie Sindoni; great-aunt & uncle Jim and Carole Daddona, uncle Scott Vanderpool, aunt Kathy Sindoni; close family friends Pat, Dave, Brian, Andrea, and Jeffery Pelachick; cousins Mason Vanderpool, Makenzie Lantz, Brittany McGee, Melissa Daddona, Candace and Dan Atkins, best friend since the age of 2 Ryan Lantz; mentor & big brother Shawn Bradley; as well several other cousins, friends, and relatives.
