



## Charles "Chuck" A. Rubert

February 10, 1933 - February 28, 2018

Charles "Chuck" A. Rubert passed away peacefully on Wednesday, February 28 at the Skilled Nursing Unit in Towanda with his daughter and son bedside. He was 85 years old.

Born in North Towanda on February 10, 1933, he was the son of the late Lawrence T. Rubert and Ruth Harris Rubert. Chuck graduated in June 1951 from Towanda High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army from 1953 – 1955 during the Korean conflict. On October 1, 1955, Chuck married Millyne Nickeson at the Hornbrook Methodist Church. He was a resident of Hornbrook for 58 years, serving as a township auditor and as treasurer of the Hornbrook Cemetery Association for 20 years. He was the Earned Income Tax Officer for Sheshequin and Ulster Townships for a number of years. Chuck was employed by GTE Sylvania from 1952 to 1985, progressing to Supervisor of Accounting for the Chemicals and Powders Business Unit at the time of his early retirement. For the next 10 years, he worked as the Fiscal Officer for B/S/S/T Area Agency on Aging.

Chuck was an avid sportsman, playing baseball, softball and basketball on teams in the area. Chuck and his wife Millyne were well known in the square dance community. They were members of the Grand Paraders in Troy, the Southern Tier Wheelers (an RV camping and Dancing Club) at Campbell, N.Y. and the Kast Arounds in Elmira, NY. While in retirement, he also enjoyed playing tennis, both in Towanda and Mesa, Arizona. Chuck was a familiar face in the local sporting community and especially enjoyed watching his

grandchildren and great-grandchildren participate in their sports.

He is survived by: daughter Cindy (Larry) Barto of Towanda, PA; son Kevin (Amanda) Rubert of Towanda, PA; his brother, Lawrence Rubert of Sayre, PA; five grandchildren: Tonia Irish, Stephanie Harris, Nicholas, Adam and Ben Rubert; seven great-grandchildren: Hallie, Ryan, Jewlz, Talen, Teagan, Tymbur, Taryn and several nieces and nephews, especially Lynn, a nephew who lived next door.

He was predeceased by his parents Lawrence & Ruth Rubert, a beloved son "Chuckie" Rubert lost in a tragic horseback accident on March 27, 1970, his brother Kenneth Rubert, his wife Millyne on January 5, 2009, and his sister Shirley Goodenow.

A private graveside service will be held at the convenience of the family at the Hornbrook Cemetery, Sheshequin Township, PA.
