Charles W. Mosier, 77, of Liberty Corners, PA passed away early Tuesday morning, March 19, 2024, at Guthrie Towanda Memorial Hospital. Charles was born in Towanda, PA on November 5, 1946, the son of Guyle Mosier and Alice Kelly Mosier. He was a graduate of Towanda High School with the class of 1964 and in early years was employed on the farm of Eugene and Mary Barrett. On March 31, 1966, Charles began serving with the U.S. Marine Corp during the Vietnam War where he later attained the rank of Lance Corporal. He received his honorable discharge upon completion of his military service on March 29, 1968. Following his military service, Charles began working with Proctor & Gamble in Mehoopany, PA and was later employed with the U.S. Postal Service in Towanda for 18 years along with operating his farm in Liberty Corners which he greatly enjoyed. He also loved the outdoors, deer hunting, and archery.
