Charles Paul "Chuck" Radney, 81, of South Waverly, PA passed away Friday, March 15, 2013 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre. "Chuck" as he was known by his family and friends was born in Sayre, PA on August 6, 1931 the son of Amos and Florence Webster Radney. He was a graduate of St. Agnes High School in Towanda class of 1950. In January of 1951, Chuck joined the U.S. Army where he served as a paratrooper during the Korean War beginning with the Second Infantry and later transferred to the 187th Airborne Combat Division. He subsequently served in Japan until the completion of his military service in January of 1954. On August 13, 1955, Chuck married Mary Carolyn McKernan and together they raised six children. Chuck was employed by National Homes in Horseheads, NY from 1955 to 1965 and later went to work for Osram Sylvania in Towanda from 1966 until his retirement in 1992.

He enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren, traveling, bowling and watching basketball and NASCAR racing. He was a member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 and Towanda Elks Lodge No. 2191.
