



## Clara Ulmer Hauser

June 11, 1928 - October 31, 2013

Clara (Ulmer) Hauser, 85, passed quietly into her Savior's presence on October 31, 2013. She was born on June 11, 1928 to Watson and Mary Alice (Getz) Ulmer on the family homestead farm in Anthony Township near Williamsport, Pa. Her entire life was one of loving service to her family, church and community. On July 6, 1949 she married Darris ("Doc") Hauser and became a devoted pastor's wife in Hunt's Corners, NY and 43 years in Towanda, Pa at the Independent Baptist Church. She loved to knit, crochet, embroider, sew, cook and entertain. Many brides, newborns and numerous others have been the recipients of her loving talent. The correspondence needs of many missionaries were cared for because of her dependable efforts in preparing and mailing their letters. She served for almost 50 years as treasurer of the Ladies Missionary Fellowship and at least 40 years as a Sunday school teacher. The Towanda chapter of the American Red Cross saw faithful years of volunteering with blood drives and the military hot line. Through her involvement with the Towanda Women's club, she showed her love for her community. She was predeceased by her husband Darris Metzger Hauser in 2003, her daughter-in-law Cynthia Fink Hauser in 2013 and an infant grandson in 1977 as well as all of her siblings: Paul, Glenn, Dale, Leon, Kathryn, and Carl. She is survived by her three sons, Kevin, Leland (Rebecca), Donn (Lynnette); seven grandchildren: Michael (Jasmine), Amanda (Sean), Elizabeth (Joshua), Darren, Rachel, Scott (Rachel), Stacey and five great grandchildren: Brendan, Adara, Genevieve, Abigail, Evangeline.

She also loved her extended family dearly.
