Cynthia Ruth "Cindi" Potter Mize, 67, of North Orwell, PA passed away peacefully Tuesday morning December 2, 2025, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. "Cindi" was born in Towanda, PA on November 28, 1958, to loving parents Richard J. Potter and Frances Brown Potter fondly known by many as "Ma Potter" and "Grandma Potter". Cindy was a graduate of Northeast Bradford High School with the class of 1976. She began her working career with Hoffman's Clothing Store on Main Street in Towanda and at the same time worked privately as a professional housekeeper in the area. She was later employed by Sturzen's Furniture in Towanda for many years and subsequently served as manager of the Antler Ridge Winery in Rome, PA until June 10, 2007, when she was involved as a passenger in a boating accident on the Intercoastal Waterway, Myrtle Beach, S.C., a traumatic event which changed her life.

Though paraplegia placed Cindi's confinement to her wheelchair, she maintained her faith and deep love and devotion for family, friends, and caregivers and love and concern for others. Using her special gifts as a creative decorator, Cindi found purpose in bringing her insight, vision, thoughts, ideas, and constructive direction to reality in various projects whether at church, home, or wherever needed. Cindi enjoyed attending the North Orwell Union Church, Rome Methodist Church and singing with her family members, the Potter Sisters when she was able. Cindi's family includes her siblings, Claudia M. LaBarre and husband David LaBarre of Windham

Township, Richard C. Potter and wife Marilyn Potter of LeRaysville, Carol D. Chaffee and husband Barry Chaffee of Orwell Township, Karen P. Evans and husband Bart Evans of Rome, Julia M. Potter of LeRaysville, Keith R. Potter and wife Tammy Potter of Newton, WI, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, friends, and caregivers.

She was predeceased by her husband, Randy Spencer Mize on August 25, 2007, father, Richard J. Potter on August 21, 2009, and mother, Frances Brown Potter on May 3, 2019.
