David Edwin Newton, 75, of 999 Echo Beach Road, Towanda, PA went home to be with the Lord, Sunday evening, March 8, 2020 from the Skilled Nursing Unit of Guthrie Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA.

David was born at Mills Hospital in Towanda on March 10, 1944, the son of Niles Andrew Newton Sr. and Leona Gertrude Mayo Newton. He was a graduate of Wyalusing Valley High School with the Class of 1962, the Practical Bible Institute in Johnson City, NY, and Cedarville College in Cedarville, OH. David was a veteran of the Vietnam War having served with the U.S. Army from April 21, 1969 to January 21, 1971 with most of his military service in Germany.
