David M. Sturdevant , 81, of New Albany, Pa. died August 19, 2024 at UPMC Hospital in Williamsport, Pa. with his loving friends at his side. He was born April 14, 1943 at Towanda, Pa., a son of Mark Sturdevant Jr. and Myrtle Decker Sturdevant.

After graduating from Wyalusing Valley High School in 1961, Dave attended Penn State University and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree. He proudly served in the U.S Air Force as an Intel officer during the Vietnam War until he was honorably discharged with the rank of captain in 1969.

He worked several years at the First National Bank of Bradford County as a loan officer until the bank was sold and then began employment at Harris Homes in Milan as a home sales consultant until his retirement.

Dave was a quiet, reserved, kind-hearted man who enjoyed traveling, scuba diving, and driving his corvettes in his younger years. He also enjoyed listening to music and owned a large collection of vinyl records/cassettes to show for it. Since he never married, he considered his dogs his family and held a great love for them. He was looking forward to the day when he would be forever united with them.

He was predeceased by his parents and his brother, Robert Sturdevant. He is survived by three nephews, John Sturdevant and Ronald Sturdevant of Boyertown, PA and Jody Sturdevant of South Branch, Monroeton, PA. He greatly loved his nephews and made sure he prayed for each of them daily. Dave was a member of the New Albany Baptist Church and considered its

parishioners his church family.

In addition to his nephews, he is survived by Darla Treaster in whom he referred to as his “best forever friend” and his “guardian angel”. Even though their friendship was only six months in duration, it was a God-Ordained, spiritual friendship that blossomed rapidly. They made each other laugh all the time, since they shared the same quirky sense of humor. The friendship was based on their mutual love for Jesus their Savior and they helped each other grow tremendously in their faith. Dave and Darla considered each other family, and eagerly await the day when they will be reunited again.
