Dean Erwin Madigan, 71, of Towanda, PA passed away peacefully at home Friday morning, April 24, 2026, following declining health.

Dean was born in Towanda Township on August 22, 1954, the son of the late Clifton B. Madigan and Ruth L. (Williams) Madigan. He grew up on the Madigan Family Farm in Luthers Mills and was a 1972 graduate of Troy High School.

Dean continued his education and received his associates degree at Alfred State College with the Ag & Tech program majoring in Agri Business. Dean served as an independent consultant with Brookside Laboratories providing soil testing and crop consulting for area farms and purchased his grandfather's farm in Burlington Township which he operated during his lifetime. Dean loved farming, the outdoors, pasture walks, green grass, gardening, landscaping, and hunting. Dean was gifted with many talents including construction, carpentry, animal husbandry, and had a mind for creative thinking and problem solving. He possessed a great love for his family and enjoyed simple pleasures like riding his motorcycle in his younger years, reading books, and eating cookies and ice cream. Dean was a devout Christian, strong in his faith and a faithful member of the Independent Baptist Church, Towanda, where he taught Sunday school, was an Usher, served as a Trustee, Treasurer, and as chairman of the Finance Committee. Dean will be remembered for his quiet strength, refusing to give up, and for never once complaining about the hardships that he endured.
