After a short stay at the Bradford County Manor, she decided to enjoy her remaining days with her family & friends in the comfort of her own home on Barclay Mountain on Hospice care.

She left this world quietly & peacefully with a small smile on her face having lived a crazy, wild & full life and knowing she was with the love of her life, George Carlisle.

Dee enjoyed playing Bingo, going to the Casinos, crafting, reading, playing her on-line games, & face painting at the local fairs but more than anything she loved spending time with her Family & George. And she loved with all her heart! When Dee loved you, you knew you were loved!, When she hugged you, you knew you had just been hugged! When you talked to her, important or not, she listened. She offered everything she had to anyone that needed it.

Friends, family, strangers, her table or a couch was always ready for whoever showed up!

Having grown up in Manyunk, (Philadelphia) PA during the Depression with 8 other siblings, she saw her share of struggles. She went on to raise

5 children of her own, 11 grandchildren, & even 3 great-grandsons that are proud to call her Mom & Nanny. Sometimes working several jobs to make ends meet, mostly factory work or waitressing, she still made time to make "family time" a priority. When Dee met George, "Pop" to us, in 1975 she finally knew she had found happiness. She had found her soul mate and someone who would return to her the love she had always so generously given out. They hunted and vacationed for a few years before moving from New Jersey to Barclay Mountain in 1989 to stay and make it home.
