Donald E. Bishop, 55, of Ulster, PA passed away suddenly Saturday, February 8, 2014 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Don was born in Towanda, PA on July 1, 1958 the son of Jack and Irene Spencer Bishop. He was a graduate of Athens Area High School with the class of 1976. Following the strong and dedicated work ethic tradition of their parents, Don and his brothers Steve and Andy formed Bishop Brothers Construction in 1983 as a residential construction company and expanded the business over the years. Don formerly served as an Ulster Township Supervisor and was president of the Ulster Cemetery Association. He was a social member of Beirne-Webster VFW Post in Towanda and was a former member of the Ulster Chamber of Commerce, Ulster-Sheshequin Fire Company, and the Southern Tier Ropers Association. Don loved the outdoors, horses, attending rodeos, team roping (healer), golfing, fishing, grilling but most of all he loved spending time with his family.
