



Donald Lynn Roach Sr.

July 10, 1934 - October 16, 2016

The Lord called “Don - Our Loved One” home on Sunday, October 16, 2016.

Don was Protestant by faith. Don had been a resident at Guthrie Towanda Memorial Hospital Skilled Nursing, Towanda, PA for some time.

Donald Lynn Roach, Sr. of Luthers Mills, PA was born, July 10, 1934 at Adrian Hospital, Punxsutawney, PA – the home of the famous or infamous “Punxsutawney Phil.” Don was the third child of 6 children born to the late Dorothy Bish Roach and Robert Lynn Roach and Anna R. Himes Roach, his step-mother; 5 Siblings: Robert Lee Roach; Ethel May Roach Hess Krenciglovia; Elva Elizabeth McKee; Earl William Roach and Marjorie Louise McMasters Lantz. He is survived by his wife Rosanna and his 4 children: Donald, Roxann, William and Concetta; one Aunt – Sydney Bish Knapp. He is also survived by several cousins, nieces and nephews, 11 - grandchildren; 12 - great grandchildren and 1 great-great grandchild.

He attended schools at Anita, PA and following school was employed for a period of one year by Hoffman Brothers of Punxsutawney, PA, diamond – core drillers testing for coal, gas, and oil deposits. Since that time had worked in right-of-way work with a number of companies. In 1957, Don came to work in the area for Geer’s Tree Service where he met his soon to be wife, Rosanna Marie Henley. Don was drafted by the United States Army in 1957 and served in Honolulu, HI during peace time as a track service mechanic. Don returned to work in January 1959 for Geer’s Tree Service for a total of ten years of service.

When Don returned to work in Towanda, PA in January, 1959 he picked up his relationship with Rosanna. They were married on June 12, 1959 at the United Methodist Parish in Towanda, PA. To them were born 4 children: Donald Lynn Roach, Jr. – married: Deneen Marie Lewis Roach; Roxann Marie Roach Stevens – married: Eric Thomas Stevens; William Lee Roach married Sheila Hart (first wife) and Ramona House Williams Groover Roach (second wife); Concetta Renee Roach – married: Nathan Edward Gallow.

On November 1, 1966, Geer Tree Service was incorporated into the family of Claverack Rural Electric Cooperative, Don was then employed under the job classification of Tree Trimmer – Power. His duties with the Right-of-Way Crew included: assisting in clearing and maintenance using both power equipment and chemicals to act as Right-of-Way Foreman in the foreman's absence. He also was a linesman.

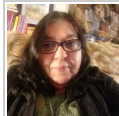
