Doris A. Reese Baker, 91, of New Albany, PA formerly of Poplar St. Towanda, PA passed away Wednesday morning, January 28, 2015.

Doris was born at Seeley's Creek, PA on February 22, 1923 the daughter of Claude Elmer Reese and Jessie Belknap Reese. She was a graduate of Prattsburg, NY High School class of 1941 and later worked in the Owego, NY area for two years. On March 19, 1954 she married Arthur L. Baker in Owego. The couple made their home in Wysox, PA until 1961 when they moved to Poplar St. in Towanda where they resided for 44 years. Doris worked as a bookkeeper for the Martin Oil Company in Wysox for a number of years and later served in the cafeterias of the J. Andrew Morrow School and the Towanda Middle School where she retired as manager in 1983. Doris and her husband Arthur enjoyed spending their winter months in Winter Haven, FL. for many years. Doris was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Towanda, the United Methodist Women, Ugly Quilt Club and the Critchlow Class.

Surviving are her son and daughter-in-law, Robert R. Baker and Tina Kellogg of New Albany with whom she resided for the past 10 years, several nieces and nephews and her caregivers, Joyce Kipp and Peggy Minnier. In addition to her parents, Doris was preceded in death by her husband of 42 years, Arthur on October 4, 1996, sisters, Eleanor Nistok, Pearl Halstead and Florence Allen and brothers, Earl Reese, Claude Reese Jr., and Clinton Reese.
