Doris B. Lewis, 94, passed away Sunday, November 10, 2024. She was born at home, the daughter of William (Billy) Burgess and Flora Conklin Burgess on February 1, 1930. She attended school at Ulster and was valedictorian of her class in 1948. She worked for some time at Sayre Lingerie but was then hired at Sylvania Electric, Inc. for a position in the Analytical Lab which she thoroughly enjoyed.

She retired from Sylvania-GTE after 35 years. In 1956 she married Raymond Lewis and they spent 47 years together before his passing in 2003. They traveled from Hawaii to a riverboat ride up the Mississippi to seeing Princess Ann on her wedding day in London and many places in between.

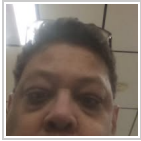
