



Dorothy M. "Dot" Korb

May 16, 1928 - March 9, 2018

Dorothy M. "Dot" Korb, 89, of Monroeton, PA passed away Friday morning, March 9, 2018 at the Lankenau Medical Center in Wynnewood, PA. "Dot" as she was known by her family and friends was born in Honesdale, PA on May 16, 1928 the daughter of the late Charles and Philippine Klein Markle. She was a graduate of Honesdale High School with the class of 1946. Following high school, Dot served in several secretarial positions in the Honesdale area. On May 20, 1950, she married Robert J. Korb and they had 41 years together before Bob's death on November 13, 1991. Dot was a "full time mom" for many years before returning to work in Towanda after moving to Monroeton in 1967. She retired from the Bradco Supply Company in 1990 having worked there for 17 years. Following her retirement, Dot served as a volunteer with American Red Cross Bloodmobiles, in service to military families, Widowed Persons Service and at the Bradford County Manor. A life-long member of the Lutheran Church which began at birth and baptism in St. John's Lutheran Church in Honesdale, Dot became a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Towanda, PA in 1967, and was an active member there. She was a member of the church council, choir, Vesper Guild, Willing Workers and formerly served as church treasurer. A love of music from a young age allowed Dot to enjoy singing with many choirs and other groups over the years. She also played string bass in several symphony orchestras in the Honesdale and Port Jervis areas.

Dot could be seen walking often in and around Monroeton and enjoying all of God's creation.

Dot was blessed with a loving family, church family, many friends and neighbors.
