



## Dorothy M. Swackhammer Schultz

September 9, 1922 - November 12, 2017

Dorothy M. Swackhamer Schultz, 95, widow of Joseph W. "Joe" Schultz formerly of Standing Stone, PA passed away Sunday evening, November 12, 2017, at the Bradford County Manor in West Burlington Township, PA. Dorothy was born in Rummerfield, PA on September 9, 1922 the daughter of Jesse E. and Mabel Hankinson Swackhamer. Dorothy was a graduate of Towanda High School Class of 1940. On July 31, 1948, she married Joseph W. Schultz. In 1962, Dorothy and Joe renovated their welding shop into the Mill stone Inn at Macedonia which they operated until 1978. Dorothy also assisted her husband Joe and brother-in-law, Charles Robert "Bob" Schultz in the operation of the Schultz Wilbert Vault Company in Wysox from 1960 to 1980 and served as caretaker of the Oak Hill Cemetery in Towanda with her husband for many years. She was predeceased by her husband of 50 years, Joe, on May 20, 1999.

Dorothy served many offices as a member of the Wysox Rebekah Lodge No. 443. She was a member of the Standing Stone United Methodist Church and served as secretary for the Standing Stone Cemetery Association for many years. She was also a life time member of the Towanda American Legion Post 42 Auxiliary where she served on many councils and held many offices throughout the years. One of her biggest joys was awarding the citizenship award to the youth of Bradford County. Dorothy also was a proud bell ringer for the Salvation Army at Christmas time. Dorothy remained an active member of her community until the time of her death.
