Dorothy Jones Schmieg, 89, a long-time resident of Lake Wesauking, PA passed away Saturday, January 4, 2014 at Gulfside Regional Hospice in Zephyrhills, FL. Dorothy was born in Shamokin, PA on December 3, 1924 the daughter of Russell and Sarah Hoover Jones. She was a graduate of Shamokin High School and in early years was employed in the garment manufacturing industry in Shamokin. On June 25, 1953 she married James R. Schmieg in Shamokin and the couple made their home on the family farm at Lake Wesauking. Dorothy was employed by the Farm Credit Bureau in Wysox for 10 years and was subsequently employed by the First National Bank of Bradford County in Towanda and Wysox for many years until her retirement.
