E. Marie Wurtenburg Allis, 97, widow of Rodney B. Allis of Main St. Rome, PA passed away Saturday morning, August 18, 2012 at the Skilled Nursing Unit of Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Marie was born January 20, 1915 in Orwell Twp., PA the daughter of the late Carl and Christine Goff Wurtenburg. She was a graduate of Rome High School and later attended one year of high school at Union Endicott in Endicott, NY. She was subsequently employed as an operator at the telephone office in Nichols, NY for Mrs. Fern Cowan. On June 29, 1938, Marie married Rodney B. Allis. The couple celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary in 2008 with a gathering of family and friends. She was preceded in death by her husband on September 13, 2008. Marie later served as telephone operator for the Rome, PA exchange for two years. Marie provided care for her grandparents Bertie and Bessie Goff until their passing in the early 1950's and then provided care for Leon and Mary Taylor until their passing. Marie served as Secretary for Rome Borough for many years.

She was a devoted member of the Rome United Methodist Church for 86 years and was the oldest and longest living member of the church at the time of her death. Marie faithfully served her church in various capacities as a church officer, choir and UMW member and served with her husband Rodney as church custodians for many years.
