Edith J. Fulda, 88, formerly of Ellis Hill, Asylum Township, PA passed away Sunday, July 13, 2014 at the Skilled Nursing Unit of Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA.

Edith was born at home in Towanda, PA on December 3, 1925 the daughter of Ralph B. and Mabel E. Robinson Jacoby. She graduated with the Commercial Course of Study from Towanda High School on June 3, 1943. Following graduation, Edith became employed by the Pennsylvania Electric Company as a stenographer. She was named clerk in 1946, intermediate senior clerk in 1948 and confidential secretary in 1974 remaining in that position until her retirement in 1982 with 39 years of service.

Edith was united in marriage to Fred W. Fulda on October 30, 1971 at the First Presbyterian Church in Owego, NY. The couple enjoyed fishing and boating at their residence at Keuka Lake during the warm months. They spent their winter months in the Bradenton, FL area. Edith was an active member of the French Asylum United Methodist Church, a 60 year member of the Rebekah Lodge and was a member of the Penelec Retirees Club. Edith will always be remembered for her love of schnauzer dogs. She is survived by several nieces and nephews, great nieces, great nephews and many good friends and neighbors who she was thankful for having them in her life. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband Fred on

December 17, 1992 and her brother, Howard S. Jacoby.

The funeral and committal service will be held Wednesday, July 16, 2014 at 12 p.m. at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home 217 York Ave. Towanda, PA with Rev. James Hollister officiating.
