



## Edward Charles Coe

March 28, 1948 - January 31, 2025

Edward Charles Coe, 76, of Ulster, PA passed away Friday, January 31, 2025, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Edward was born at the Tioga General Hospital in Waverly, NY on March 28, 1948, the son of Edward E. Coe and Armentia (Cole) Coe. He was a 1966 graduate of Sayre High School and on August 18, 1966, he entered the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War to serve until completion of his military service on May 18, 1970. Edward began his working career with Westinghouse in Horseheads, NY and was later employed by Ingersoll-Rand in Athens, American Car in Sayre, and retired from the maintenance department of the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre following 25 years of service due to declining health.
