Edward J. "Jerry" Webster Sr., 77, of 112 Ward Ave. Towanda, PA passed away Friday morning November 28, 2014 at his home surrounded by his loving family. "Jerry" as he was known by his family and friends was born at home on Ward Avenue in Towanda on June 9, 1937 the son of Daniel Francis Webster Sr. and Julia Agnes Jerome Webster. He attended St. Agnes School in Towanda and in early years was employed as a truck driver transporting freight for Charles Glossner to New York City. He was subsequently employed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in Towanda for 41 years until his retirement in October of 2000. Jerry was a member of SS Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Towanda Gun Club, Towanda Area Senior Citizens, AARP and Franklin Steam Engine Company No. 1 which became the Towanda Fire Department in 1999. Jerry served in all of the line officer positions of the Towanda Fire Department and as Towanda Boro Fire Chief from 1972-1973, 1988-1989 and 1992-1993. He was presently serving as 2nd Assistant Chief until the time of his passing. Jerry was also a charter member and past assistant chief of North Towanda Fire and Rescue. He loved to travel, enjoyed traditional country music and was an avid hunter, snow mobiler and NASCAR fan.
