Edward J. Namet, 83, of Sayre, PA passed away early Sunday morning, June 14, 2015 at the Sayre Health Care Center, Athens Township, PA. Ed was born in Sayre on September 26, 1931 the son of Wesley L. and Edna Mae Cole Namet. He grew up on Sayre's East Side, was a graduate of Sayre High School class of 1949 and was a veteran of the Korean and Viet Nam Wars having served with the U.S. Marine Corps from February 1950 to 1954 and then with the U.S. Air Force from August 1954 to 1971. Ed graduated from Elmira College in 1981 where he received his Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and Social Science and Associate's degree in Police Science. He was employed by the Bradford County Probation Department in Towanda for 24 years until his retirement in September of 1995. Ed was a member of the Church of the Epiphany, Skiff Bower VFW Post No. 1536, American Legion Post No. 283, Sayre, and the Air Force Sargent's Association, Washington, DC.

He is survived by several nieces, nephews and many good friends. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brother, Wesley Namet.

A mass of Christian burial will be held Wednesday, June 17, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. at the Church of the Epiphany, South Elmer Ave., Sayre.
