



## Elizabeth "Arlene" Myers Nalisnick

Elizabeth "Arlene" Myers Nalisnick, 77, of North Towanda, PA passed away Thursday evening, October 3, 2024, at Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. "Arlene" as she was known by her family and friends was born January 1, 1947, in Cresson, PA the daughter of the late George Myers and Pearl Irene (Adams) Myers. She was a graduate of Cresson Joint High School, Cresson, PA with the class of 1964 and continued her education in nursing at the Mercy School of Nursing in Altoona, PA.
