Eric Gordon "Rick" Secor, 72, of Towanda Township, PA passed away peacefully at home Monday morning, April 1, 2024. "Rick" as he was known by his family and many friends was born in Easton, PA February 17, 1952, the son of Gordon S. Secor and Barbara Dimon Secor. He was a graduate of Northeast Bradford High School with the class of 1970. Rick began his working career as a union drywaller in the Binghamton, NY area and was subsequently employed as a sales representative for Coolbaugh's Auto Sales in North Towanda and Moore's Auto Sales in Wysox.
