



Evelyn Marie "Evey" Maryott

August 18, 1929 - January 31, 2014

Evelyn Marie "Evey" Myers Maryott, 84, of Tomahawk Road, North Towanda, Pa., passed away Friday morning, Jan. 31, 2014 following declining health. "Evey," as she was known by her family and friends, was born at home on Elizabeth Street in Towanda, Pa. on Aug. 18, 1929, the second child and second daughter of LeRoy H. Myers and Alberta Iva Battin Myers. She attended the Towanda schools and graduated from Towanda High School in the class of 1948. As a student, Evey was very active in school functions and activities including 6 years in both the choir and Glee Club, 6 years with the school paper, The Oriole, and served as assistant editor of the school's first yearbook, the Tohimeki. Evey also played the oboe in the junior high school orchestra. In her senior year, Evey represented Towanda High School at the Pennsylvania State Laurel Festival in Wellsboro, Pa., and was escorted by her future husband William J. "Bill" Maryott. During her senior year, Evey was employed by the Keystone Theatre in Towanda in various capacities and was subsequently employed by the American Red Cross and by GTE Sylvania in Towanda where she retired following 29 years of service. On Dec. 26, 1950, Evey and Bill who was serving with the U.S. Marine Corp at that time, were married at Christ Episcopal Church in Towanda. The couple resided at Camp Pendleton, Calif. for a time where they made many friends with whom they remained in contact for over 60 years. Evey and Bill purchased their first home in Monroeton and later purchased a small farm in Franklindale where they raised their 4 children. Evey spent many happy years on the farm with

her husband Bill and children caring for their animals, riding bikes, playing baseball and horseshoes, swimming in their pool, picking fruit and berries, fishing in the pond and holding barbecues on the patio for family and friends. Many memorable times were enjoyed there especially when the children returned home from college bringing friends home with them. In early years, Evey was active in the Iona Grange and Franklin Fire Company Auxiliary as well as Sunday school and the PTA. Evey enjoyed bowling and camping especially the family trip to the Pacific coast and back. Following Bill's passing on Feb. 27, 1985, Evey left the farm to purchase a home in North Towanda. Surviving are her children Mark (Beth) of Perkasie, Pa., Guy (Tamar) of Monroeton, Konni (Dana) Russell of Myersburg, Eric (Jessica) of Franklindale; granddaughters Kathleen Russell, Ashley (Clyde) Gave, Kelsey Maryott, Katie Maryott, Laura Maryott, Sarah Maryott; great-granddaughter Bailey; grandsons William Maryott, John Maryott; great-grandson Quentin Russell; sister-in-law and brother-in-law Marion and Albert Ingerick of Wysox; as well as many nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to her parents and husband, Evey was preceded in death by her sister and brother-in-law, Aileen and Ivan Gowdy, and brother and sister-in-law, Louis and Patricia Myers. The funeral service will be held Monday, Feb. 3, 2014 at noon at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home, 217 York Ave., Towanda, Pa., with Rev. Thomas Blackall officiating. Interment will follow in Bradford County Memorial Park, Luthers Mills, Pa. The family will receive friends Sunday afternoon from 1 to 4 p.m. and on Monday one hour prior to the service at the funeral home.
