



## Florence M. "Flossie" Wilcox Lines

June 29, 1924 - July 3, 2018

Florence M. "Flossie" Wilcox Lines, 94, of Monroe Township, PA passed away surrounded by her family, Tuesday afternoon, July 3, 2018, at the Bradford County Manor in West Burlington Township, PA. "Flossie" as she was known by her family and friends was born in Elmira, NY on June 29, 1924, the only child of Ralph and Florence Horton Wilcox.

In early years, she was employed by the Towanda Corset Company and Widman's Pharmacy in Towanda.

Flossie was later employed in the advertising department of The Daily Review and The Farmer's Friend in Towanda and drove school bus for a number of years.

Flossie was a well-known Avon Products representative in the area for many years and through her service acquired many friends and business relationships. Flossie was a member of the Powell United Methodist Church, Past Noble Grand and District Deputy of Wysox Rebekah Lodge No. 443, Past Worthy Matron of the Order of Eastern Star Chapter No. 76, Towanda, Past President of the Fraternal Order of Eagles Lodge, Towanda, Canton Moose Lodge, and was a Past President of the Towanda American Legion Auxiliary. Flossie was one of the founders of the Che-Hanna Rock and Mineral Club. She enjoyed making jewelry and hunting for rocks and minerals. Flossie formerly served as a scout leader for boys and girls. Flossie was a life-long Republican and was a member of the Bradford County Republican Women. She was honored to having been the only representative from Bradford

County to attend the inaugural ball for President Ronald Reagan.

She is survived by her children, Cecil Lynn Lines (JoAnn Powell) of Marysville, PA, Norma Jeanne Lines (Paul Ballentine) of Ulster, PA, Richard Duane Lines and wife Judy of Powell, Ona Grace "Chip" Lines-Burgess and husband Richard "Smokey" of Meshoppen, PA, "special daughter", Barb Lines of Wysox,

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Henry Lewis Lines Jr. on May 10, 1979.
