December 18, 1917 - October 1, 2017

Frank Emory, 99, former Monroeton Fire Chief and Monroe Boro Council member of 94 Franks Lane, Monroeton, PA passed away peacefully Sunday morning, October 1, 2017 at his home.

Frank was born in Ulysses, PA on December 18, 1917 the son of Fred and Laura Hatch Emory. In early years, Frank was employed by the O. Ames Handle Factory in Monroeton, GTE Sylvania in Towanda and by the Whitmoyer Tree Service. In later years, Frank operated his own tree service, assisted area farmers, and was known throughout the area for his expertise with explosives on numerous projects.

Frank built his own home for his loving wife Cora McNeal Emory, which he constructed of stone on his property in Monroeton.

Frank was a member of the Monroeton United Methodist Church and was a 48 year member of Evergreen Lodge No. 163 F. & A.M. Monroeton. He was a member of the Monroe Hose Company for 68 years where he served 27 years as fire chief. Frank served as a member of the Monroe Boro Council for 24 years, as Forrest Fire Warden in Bradford County for 45 years and as caretaker of the Monroeton Cemetery for many years. Frank loved the outdoors and working in the woods.

He is survived by his children, Gladys Middendorf of New Albany, Paul M. Bump and wife Linda of Towanda, and Helen House of Monroeton, 12 grandchildren, numerous great grandchildren and great great grandchildren, several nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his parents Frank was

predeceased by his wife of 62 years, Cora May McNeal Emory on October 14, 2001, brother, Jess Emery and sisters, Lucille Hunter, Florence Gavitt and Nina Martin.

The family will receive friends Thursday from 7 to 9 p.m. at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home 217 York Ave. Towanda, PA. Evergreen Lodge No. 163 F. & A.M. will hold a Masonic funeral service Thursday at 6:45 p.m. at the funeral home.
