Fred W. Bump, 90, of Towanda, "Toytown", PA passed away on Wednesday, June 5, 2019. Fred was born on March 24, 1929 in Towanda, PA.

In earlier years, Fred worked at the Berlinger Silk Mill, for Towanda Borough, and at Ingersoll-Rand. He retired from GTE Sylvania in 1989 after 36 years of service.
