



Fredrick Francis Sparduti

December 13, 1922 - April 2, 2014

Fredrick Francis Sparduti, 91, of 706 N. Elmer Ave. Sayre, PA passed away Wednesday morning, April 2, 2014 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre. Fredrick was born in Sayre on December 13, 1922 the son of Peter and Mary Mitchell Sparduti. He was a graduate of Sayre High School class of 1942. In early years, Fredrick was employed by D.G. Nicholas and later served as service and sales manager for Penn York Motors in Sayre. Fredrick was subsequently employed by the LeHigh Valley Railroad and later by Conrail until his retirement in 1976. He was a member of the Church of the Epiphany in Sayre, the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers Union, the Antique Boat Society in Clayton, NY and the Pennsylvania Sheriffs Association. Fredrick loved spending time with his grandchildren. He was an avid wood worker, was a boating enthusiast who enjoyed antique boats and was a well-known automobile mechanic in the area.

Surviving are his 3 daughters, Rosemary Rinus, Eileen Sparduti and Theresa Correll and husband Mike all of Sayre, 3 grandchildren, Donald Page and fiancé Darlene, Caitlin M. Correll and Michael F.
