Gerald Richard "Jerry Dick" Place, 74, of Sheshequin Township, PA passed away peacefully Friday April 8, 2016. Gerald was born in Sayre on December 11, 1941 the son of Gerald Frank Place and Muriel Jean King Place. He grew up on the family farm in Sheshequin Township and attended the Ulster and Athens schools. Gerald served in the U.S. Navy from 1959 to 1963 and following completion of his military service he traveled extensively throughout the United States working as a heavy equipment operator in open pit mining in the western states and with logging camps in Alaska.
