Gladys B. Durley, 93, of Rome Township, Pa. passed away Monday morning, March 10, 2014 at her home.

Gladys was born in Seymour, Conn. on April 8, 1920 the daughter of William H. and Leta K. Humiston Bice.

In her youth she attended a one-room school house and later graduated from Hillhouse High School in New Haven, Conn. with the class of 1938. During World War II, Gladys served as a comptometer operator for the U.S. Rubber Company in Naugatuck, Conn. In later years after raising her family, Gladys completed teacher aide training and school librarian courses and eventually served in the Woodbridge, Conn. Elementary School as a teaching aide and as school librarian. Gladys also served as a volunteer at the New Haven, Conn. Food Bank for 14 years. She was formerly an active member of the First Church of Christ Congregational in Bethany, Conn. and attended the Dille Parish United Church of Christ in LeRaysville and Potterville, Pa. Gladys was a member of the Ugly Quilters Group and enjoyed knitting, sewing needlework, square dancing and was an avid reader.

Surviving are her children, Theodore B. Durley and wife Marsha L. Durley of Plymouth, Conn., Alice-Rae Clock and husband Gilbert H. Clock of Herrick Township, Pa., Eve N. Herrington of Orwell Township, Pa.; 8 grandchildren; 14

great-grandchildren; as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, Theodore John Durley in August of 1977; grandson, Stephen H. Herrington IV.; son-in-law, Stephen H. Herrington III.; sister and brother-in-law, Alice and Ed Bunton; and brother and sister-in-law, Ray and Audrey Bice.

A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, March 15, 2014, at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home, 217 York Ave., Towanda, Pa., with Rev. Tom Burlington of the Dille Parish United Church of Christ of LeRaysville and Pottersville officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service at the funeral home.
