Glenn James Meisenhelter Sr., 87, of 507 William St., Towanda, Pa., passed away early Tuesday morning, Nov. 26, 2013 at the Skilled Nursing Unit of Memorial Hospital, Towanda, Pa. Glenn was born Oct. 4, 1926 in York, Pa., one of 11 children of Ellis and Emma Sweitzer Meisenhelter. He was a graduate of Dover High School, Dover, Pa., in the class of 1944 and later in that same year enlisted in the U.S. Navy where he served during World War II. On June 4, 1950 he married Sally Smith in York, Pa. Glenn received his Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering from Gettysburg College in 1952 and was subsequently employed by GTE Sylvania in Towanda from 1952 until his retirement in 1985. Glenn was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Towanda, Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 and the post's World War II Last Man's Club, Beirne-Webster VFW Post No. 1568, Towanda, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Lodge No. 2191, Towanda, Towanda Gun Club and the Towanda Country Club. Glenn loved playing golf and bowling, playing cards and watching football. He is survived by his devoted wife of 63 years, Sally Meisenhelter, at home; children Cathy M. Meisenhelter of Athens, James E. Meisenhelter of Hollywood, Fla., Glenn J. Meisenhelter Jr. of Margate, Fla.; sister Amanda Slotterbeck of Comar, Ga.; and brothers Charles Meisenhelter of Shawnee, Kansas, Arvil Meisenhelter of York, Pa.; brother-in-law James W. Smith of York, Pa., as well as numerous, nieces, nephews and cousins. A private interment service will be held at Woodlawn National Cemetery, Elmira, N.Y. Arrangements are under the
