Guy R. Cook, 54, of Albany Township, PA passed away unexpectedly Friday, October 9, 2015 at his home where he had been resting following a recent automobile accident.

Guy was born October 18, 1960 in Sayre, PA the son of Sally Johnston Cook and the late Richard K. Cook.

He was a graduate of Towanda Area High School with the class of 1978 where he was active in football and wrestling. Following high school Guy went to work for GTE Sylvania in Towanda and was subsequently employed by Masonite Corporation in Wysox for two years. He returned to work at GTE Sylvania which later became GTP in Towanda and remained there until his retirement. Guy was a member of the Monroeton Rod & Gun Club, was a social member of American Legion Post No. 42 and Beirne Webster VFW Post No. 1568 in Towanda and was a former member of the Towanda Elks Lodge. Guy loved spending time at his home and being outdoors, hunting and four wheeling. Guy was always a dedicated hard-worker who took great pride and passion in caring for his property which he purchased from his grandmother Pearl B. Johnston in February of 1993. Guy was a devoted supporter of disabled veterans organizations and muscular degeneration research as well as numerous charitable organizations.

Cook on June 13, 2007 and by his grandson, Austin Jordan Cook on October 29, 2009.
