January 31, 1924 - December 18, 2012

Harold Richard Jayne, 88, of Hornbrook, PA passed away Tuesday, December 18, 2012 at Memorial Hospital, Towanda, PA. Harold was born in Laceyville, PA on January 31, 1924 the son of Leslie and Eva Jayne. He grew up living in a log cabin on the family farm and assisted his parents in the operation of the farm from a young age. Harold later served in the U.S. Army during World War II in Germany and was the recipient of two Bronze Stars. On September 10, 1943 he married Ruth Ellen Kingsley. In early years, Harold was employed by the Laceyville Charcoal Company, Masonite Corporation and drove a gas truck. He later owned and operated the H & R Country Store, The Maple Leaf Inn, a car crushing business and H & R Paving Company for a number of years. Harold also operated several concession stand trailers over the years providing food service at carnivals and area events. Following his retirement, he enjoyed attending auctions and traveling the United States in his motor home spending the winter months in Florida. Harold attended the Monroeton United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Ruth who is a resident of the Skilled Nursing Unit in Towanda, son and daughter-in-law, Fred and Betty Jayne of Wysox, grandchildren, Jennifer (Rob) Burke, Timothy (Tiffanie) Jayne, Craig (Brenda) Jayne and Penny Jayne and several great grandchildren and great great grandchildren.
