June 23, 1916 - September 11, 2015

Harold Phelps, 99 years young and a lifetime resident of Ulster, PA, passed away early Friday morning, September 11, 2015 at the Robert Packer Hospital. Harold was born in Ulster on June 23, 1916, the son of Andrew and Mary E. Titchen Phelps. Well known to many as "Mr. Veal", he owned and operated his farm in Ulster and had been a very active cattle dealer throughout the area and traveled to Bellville PA often in his Cattle Truck. He enjoyed his trips to Wyalusing Stock Yards and his visits at Vaughn Jennings farm in LeRoy. In his younger years, he assisted his family with Phelps Market in Ulster and later ran it after his fathers passing. In his later years Harold was still very active in his farm and could often be seen as Co-Pilot with Ralph while hauling cattle in his prized Cattle Truck. Harold would often tell of how he'd have to go to Philadelphia to get produce for the store or he would have to go door to door selling potatoes and peaches so he could go fishing. He loved canning peaches and made sure Greta learned how to as well. He enjoyed the outdoors, hunting, fishing and camping along the Susquehanna River.

He is survived by his sister Marguerite of Ulster. Step children Dale, Fred, Diana, Greta, Jeff and Ralph. Step grand children Stacy, Kristan, Dale, John, Jeff, Michael, Nikki, Nicolas, Nicole, Patty, Meagan, Brooke and Ryan along with several nieces, nephews and cousins. Special caregivers Brandy, Rhoda and Keri.

Harold was preceded by his loving companion of 38 years Anna Hadlock, his

mother, father, and infant brother.

The family will receive friends Noon to 2pm on Wednesday September 16th at the Bowen-Farr Funeral Home, 6 Farr Street in Ulster. The funeral service will be held afterwards with Pastor Kitty Keller of the Ulster Methodist Church officiating. Interment will be in the Ulster Cemetery.
