Harold 'Harry' E. Roelands, 82, of Asylum Twp., passed away at home on Saturday, July 06, 2013. Harry was born in Palmyra, N.Y., the son of the late William F. and Helen L. Ikewood Roelands. Harry grew up in Palmyra and graduated from the Palmyra High School. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War. On January 16, 1982, Harry married Judy Sandt. Harry worked as a computer specialist for the nuclear division of FEMA until he retired in 1985, after working there for over thirty years. After retiring from FEMA, Harry and Judy moved to Asylum Twp. where he worked in real estate for several years for Kerr-Crawford.

Harry was an active member and volunteer for the Towanda American Legion Post 42, Wysox Volunteer Fire Company and Ambulance Association, and The Independent Order of Odd Fellows Lodge 1152, Wysox, where he was very active in the recycling program and the nursing scholarship program. Harry was a kind and giving person, who enjoyed life. He loved metal detecting, fishing, golfing, bowling, and working outside.

Harry is survived by his wife, Judy; children, Michael Roelands and wife, Stacy of MD, Marta Fitzpatrick of CA, Terry Roelands and wife, Debbie of CA, and Kim Roelands of CA; and nephew, Steve Roelands and wife Julie of NY. In addition to his parents, Harry is preceded in death by his brother, William 'Bill' Roelands in 1988 and sister-in-law, Priscilla Roelands in 1998.
