After a long and fulfilling life, Helen K. Finlan, 99, of Towanda, PA, passed away peacefully at home while in the care of her loving daughter Marylin. She was welcomed into heaven by her husband and son on Tuesday April 21, 2026. Helen was born in Burlington, PA on March 12, 1927; the youngest of five children of Jacob Kokoszka and Mary Szychowski Kokoszka. Growing up in East Towanda, Helen attended Towanda High School, graduating in 1946. Helen began her working career with Prudential Insurance. During this time she met her husband John Edward Finlan, whom she married on June 30, 1956. Together they shared 42 years of marriage. Helen went on to be employed by Fontaine Weaving Co, Valley Cities Gas, and Citizens and Northern Bank in Wysox, PA; where she retired in December of 1990 in anticipation of the births of her first two grandchildren.

Throughout her life, Helen was involved in various clubs and memberships such as Saints Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Parish, The Altar and Rosary Society, Catholic Daughters of America, Towanda Country Club, Win Over Weight (WOW), the Red Hat Society, and the Towanda Garden Club. After retirement, she served as Finlan's Tavern's longest employee as a bookkeeper. She loved get togethers with family and friends, spoiling her grand and great grandchildren, dancing, and of course polka music. Along with being an avid golfer and bowler, Helen enjoyed ceramics, birdwatching, gardening, reading, crossword puzzles, and admiring her picturesque view of the Susquehanna river from her front porch.

Surviving are her daughter Marylin Garris, grandchildren Raymond Jacob Finlan II (Christina), Marissa Barnett (Rhyan), and Taylor Pruyne (Codey). Great grandchildren Olivia Finlan, Aiden Barnett, Raymond Jacob Finlan III and Luke Pruyne, along with several nieces and a nephew. Helen was predeceased by her husband John Finlan (1998) and her son Raymond Finlan (2021).

“Gran” will be fondly remembered for her red lipstick by her extended family, friends, therapy staff, and aides. As she would always say “Put a little lipstick on, You’ll be fine!”
