Henry Eugene "Doc" Hoffman Jr., the "Real Doc", 96, well-known life-long resident of Towanda, PA passed away Wednesday morning, February 25, 2026. Henry was born in Towanda on December 26, 1929, the son of Henry Euguene Hoffman Sr. (Grassy) and Helen (Bride) Hoffman. He was a 1948 St. Agnes High School graduate and later served with the U.S. Army from 1952 to 1954 a Veteran of the Korean War. On November 22, 1951, Henry married Glenna C. Simons at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Towanda. "Doc" as he was known by his family and many friends was employed by GTE Sylvania in Towanda until retiring with nearly 40 years of service. Over the years, he enjoyed Sulky horse racing, playing golf, and raising beef cattle on his farm, which was one of his favorite hobbies. Doc was a member of Saints Peter and Paul Church, Towanda American Legion Post No. 42, Beirne-Webster VFW Post No.1568, Towanda, and the Towanda Country Club. He is survived by his children, Mary C. "Colleen" Hoffman Pearlman and her husband Wade of New Jersey, Henry E. "Chip" Hoffman III and his significant other Terry Gray of Towanda, Dr. Timothy J. "Tim" Hoffman and significant other Karen DiOdoardo of Towanda, grandchildren, Neysa, Melanie, Nancy, Kamri, and Kolby, 5 great grandchildren, as well as several nieces, nephews, and cousins. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his wife of 67 years, Glenna, on August 3, 2019, sisters, Catherine (Richard) Snell, Agnes (John) Griffin, Jane (Jerry) Madden, brothers, William (Joyce) Hoffman, John Hoffman, and Frank Hoffman.
