



## Howard J. Moore

August 28, 1961 - January 9, 2015

Howard J. Moore, 53, of 213 Bridge St. Athens, PA died Friday, January 9, 2015 as the result of a motor vehicle accident in Litchfield Township, PA. Howard was born in Sayre, PA on August 28, 1961 the son of Mildred Sweet Moore and the late Gary Moore. He was a graduate of Athens High School class of 1979 and following graduation enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps where he served until 1983

Following completion of his military service, Howard returned home to be employed by Athens High School and later by Grumman Allied Industries in Montgomery, PA for 10 years. He formerly served as a bus driver for the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre and was employed by New York State Electric and Gas Service. Howard was employed by Gas Field Specialists of Mainesburg, PA at the time of his death. He was a member, financial officer and former Commander of American Legion Fort Sullivan Post No. 246 in Athens and was a life member of Skiff-Bower VFW Post No. 1536 Sayre. Howard enjoyed spending time with his family especially his grandchildren and bowling.

He is survived by his mother, Mildred Moore of Athens, daughters, Staci Moore of Athens, Traci Phillips and husband John of Athens, grandchildren, Thomas, Stella and Trevor, nephew, Gary Moore of California, great nephew, Kendrick Moore, special friend, Trudy Kepner of Waverly and many good

friends. He was preceded in death by his wife, Kathleen Rose Moore in February of 1988, father, Gary Moore in July of 1987, brother, Harold "Pete" Moore in September of 1988 and sister, Rowena Moore in September of 1981.

The family will receive friends Wednesday, January 14, 2015 from 5 to 7 p.m. with a memorial service to follow at 7 p.m. at the Alteri-Bowen Funeral Home 314 Desmond St. Sayre, PA. Skiff-Bower VFW Post 1536 will accord military honors at the funeral home. Interment will be in Tioga Point Cemetery, Athens, PA. 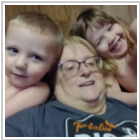
